



Flag of Nepal

Adopted on December 16, 1962.

Combination of two red pennons with a blue border, with a sun and crescent moon.

The national flag of Nepal is the world's only non-quadrilateral national flag. Its crimson red is the colour of the rhododendron, the country's national flower. Red is also the sign of victory in war. The blue border is the colour of peace.

Until 1962, the flag's emblems, the sun and the crescent moon, had human faces.
